

Regulations Regarding National Invited Professors at TKU

Secretariat Regulation No. 1060000034 (06/12/2017)

Article 1

These regulations were formulated to help facilitate university development.

Article 2

National employment applications for invited professors accords with the evaluation procedures of the TKU Faculty Review Committee.

Article 3

The invited national professor must be: an external scholar holding professor certification (or higher) that has been reviewed and verified by the Ministry of Education and who has held such certification for at least three years or who has specialized skills in a unique field. Scholars or experts who wish to have their employment extended must have achieved special accomplishments in their particular area of specialization, and have actively pursued research in their domain of expertise over the previous three years.

Article 4

Invited national professors teach intensive-style credited courses. Each credit point is equivalent to at least 18 hours of classes. Such professors may teach no more than 18 hours of classes per week and no more than four hours of classes per day.

Article 5

The hourly salary for invited national professors is twice that of regular professors. However, salary will be delivered only after calculating the actual amount of hours taught.

Article 6

The contract of invited national professors is issued by the TKU President. The professors' teaching hours, salary, and obligations are all outlined in the contract.

Article 7

This set of regulations will take effect on the date of its publication after being passed by the university-level Faculty Review Committee and approved by the TKU President. The same applies to any later amendments made.
